The perfect blow-dry will carry you through any occasion, once learnt it will be one of the best weapons in your beauty armoury. You can build on it and give it seasonal tweaks but the basics stay the same.

- 1 Prep hair with L'Oreal Professionnel tecni.art volume lift & L'Oreal Professionnel tecni.art pli and blow-dry using a ghd paddle brush.
- 2 Split the hair into six large sections one at the crown, one at the front, two at the back and two on either side.
- 3 Taking the section at the crown separate into two and lightly backcomb the piece at the back leaving the front free and place over the top of the backcombed piece. Repeat this on all six large sections.
- 4 Taking a tong wrap sections of hair around it then roll up and pin to the head, repeat this all over and leave to cool. Once cool brush the hair out with a ghd paddle brush and finish with L'Oreal Professionnel tecni.art crystal gloss.

Headmasters Does The Week:

Saturday - Do the **Pro Blow** when you have a little extra time.

Sunday - Brush out & add a little salt spray for sexy texture (easy relaxed Sunday hair).

Monday - A ponytail is smart & quick (perfect for the shock & hassle of Monday mornings!)

Tuesday - **Couture Curls** – give yourself some extra time in the morning (or we cheat & wash the night before & style the next day).

Brush out into loose waves

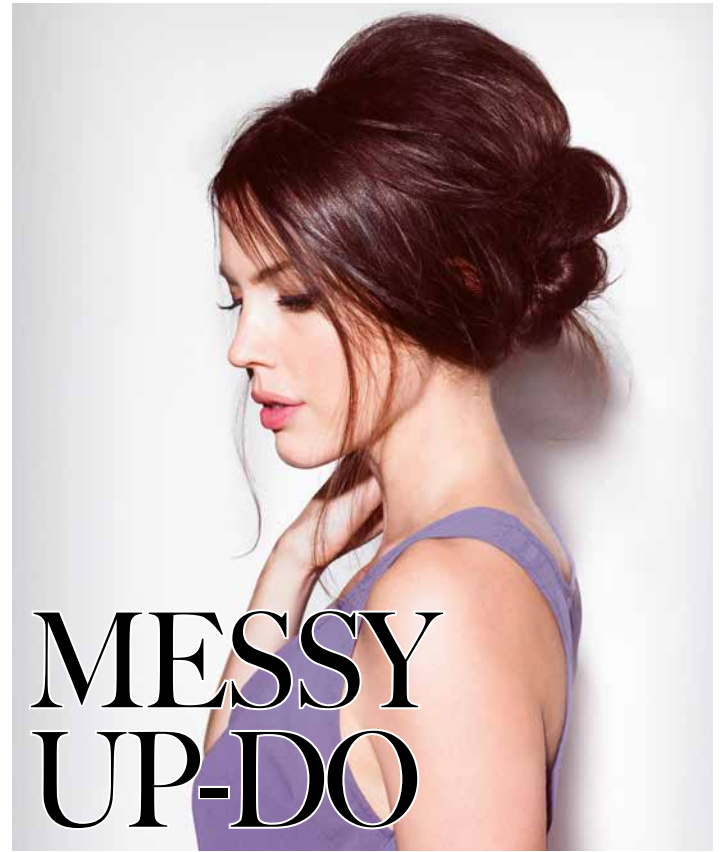
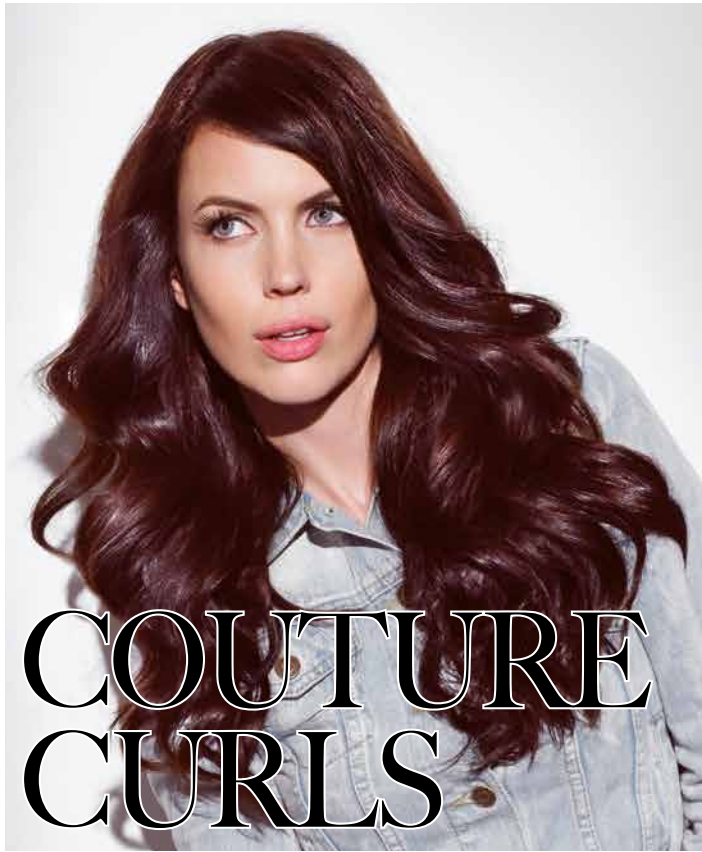
Thursday - Add a little dry shampoo & half up half down hair works.

Friday - The **Messy Up-Do** (a chic & sexy end to the week).

You will need:

L'Oreal Professionnel tecni art volume lift
L'Oreal Professionnel tecni.art pli
L'Oreal Professionnel tecni.art crystal gloss

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Avoid school-girl ringlets or limp curls that don't last the distance. Couture Curls are the right side of cool; get the bend in all the right places to flatter features, plus it won't drop all day/ night with no stiffness.

1 Prep hair with L'Oreal Professionnel tecni.art liss control and whilst hair is still damp take a random section and twist loosely with your fingers.

2 Cup the area you have twisted in your hands and dry directing the hair dryer down to avoid frizz. Repeat this all over the head until hair is 100% dry and shake out.

3 Take a triangular section around the parting and pin on top of the head then blow dry the rest of the hair section by section using a round brush to help create the curl. Once dry do the same with the section on top of the head.

4 Take random sized pieces of hair and wind like a rope then wrap around a medium tong, as this will leave the curl more defined and less uniform. Remember to leave space at the root so start from the cheekbone and curl downwards.

5 Shake out the hair using hands to give a natural diffused curl, avoid raking or combing fingers through, as this will remove the curl. To finish spritz the hair with L'Oreal Professionnel Playball Beach fizz and add a little L'Oreal Professionnel tecni.art crystal gloss for added shine.

The ultimate date night fail safe, our take on it is a little French, a little sultry and very chic. Height where it counts and loose pieces that make it look casually cool rather than too done.

1 Prep the hair with L'Oreal Professionnel tecni.art volume lift & L'Oreal Professionnel tecni.art pli and blow-dry smooth using ghd paddle brush.

2 Take random sections of hair and twist like a rope then wrap around a small tong for a stronger curl. Once cool dishevel the curls with fingers and spritz the hair with L'Oreal Professionnel Playball Beach fizz.

3 Take a teardrop shaped section three inches from hairline to below the crown, and back comb. Do this by taking a small section at a time and backcombing using a pastiche brush, remember to direct the hair in the opposite direction when backcombing, as it will help give more height.

4 Leaving a few pieces around the face to frame and the sides free pull the rest of the hair into a low pony and fasten with a bungee.

5 Taking the ends twist the pony onto a bun and pin then add the loose sidepieces into the bun and secure with pins. To keep this look really cool massage the roots and bun so give a worn look and finally spritz with L'Oreal Professionnel Playball Beach fizz for a little extra hold.
